

Bentham Syndicated Loan Fund NZD

Monthly fact sheet – April 2018

Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham Syndicated Loan Fund NZD had a total return (after standard wholesale fees*) of 0.57 percent in the month of April, outperforming the benchmark Credit Suisse Leveraged Loan Index (hedged into NZD) after fees by 0.07 percent. On a before fees* basis the fund returned 0.63 percent for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.13 percent.

The April monthly distribution paid was 0.42%**.

Fund Statistics

At month end, the Fund had a yield to maturity of 6.28% and running yield of 5.96%, with the credit yield spread^ increasing by 22 basis points to 360 basis points during the month. The Fund had an interest rate duration of 0.28 years and credit duration of 4.24 years.

Leveraged Loan Market

The top performing leveraged loan industries in April were Metals/Minerals, Energy and Food And Drug with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 1.22%, 0.84% and 0.65% respectively. The worst performing loan industries were Consumer Non-Durables, Transportation and Retail with returns of -0.34%, 0.07% and 0.27% respectively.

The discount margin (3 year) for the Index decreased by 14 bps during the month to 382 bps.

Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's asset allocations are 78.0% in Syndicated Loans, 8.1% in High Yield Bonds, 3.7% in Collateralised Loan Obligations and 10.2% in Cash & Derivative Hedges.

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 10.3% in Electronics, 8.6% in Chemicals, Plastics and Rubber and 7.9% in Diversified/Conglomerate Service. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.2% in Numericable, 1.1% in Hub and 1.1% in Burger King. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Hub International Limited, Compass IV and Inovalon Holdings, Inc; with decreased exposures to Nexstar Broadcasting Inc, Ocean Rig 1 Inc. and Viskase Companies Inc.

^{**} The monthly distribution return is calculated as the distribution amount declared for the month-end divided by the ex-distribution unit price at the start of the month. Bentham intends to achieve an average distribution rate of one month New Zealand Bank Bill Swap (NDBB1M) rate plus 3.00% - 3.50% p.a. of the monthly unit price for FY2018 with taxable income. If there is a shortfall of taxable income, the distribution could possibly include a capital return. The current distribution rate setting was based on the running yield of the Fund as at 30 June 2017 and assumes the Fund continues to achieve an equivalent yield for FY2018. Actual distributions, however, can differ from this setting because of future matters which are not known or able to be presently identified.

[^] Credit yield spread is yield to maturity above the NZD forward bank bill curve (duration adjusted swap rates).
