

Bentham Wholesale High Yield Fund

Monthly fact sheet – March 2017

Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham Wholesale High Yield Fund had a total return (after fees*) of 0.14 percent in the month of March, outperforming the benchmark Merrill Lynch High Yield Cash Pay Constrained Index (hedged into AUD) after fees by 0.28 percent. On a before fees* basis the fund returned 0.21 percent for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.35 percent.

The March quarterly distribution paid was 1.15%.

Fund Statistics

At month end, the Fund had a yield to maturity of 6.24% and running yield 6.99%, with the credit yield spread^ increasing by 7 basis points to 362 basis points during the month. The Fund had an interest rate duration of 4.16 years and credit duration of 4.06 years.

High Yield Market

For the month, 8 of the 24 industries had positive returns. The top performing industries in March were Utility, Transportation and Aerospace with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 0.40%, 0.24% and 0.18% respectively. The worst performing industries were Food And Drug, Retail and Energy with returns of -2.11%, - 1.38% and -0.95% respectively.

The credit yield spread^ for the Index increased by 19 basis points during the month to 385 basis points.

Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's asset allocations are 93.7% in High Yield Bonds, 0.0% in Syndicated Loans and 5.8% in Cash & Derivative Hedges.

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 10.5% in Buildings and Real Estate, 9.4% in Broadcasting and Entertainment and 7.7% in Oil and Gas. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.8% in Valeant Pharmaceuticals, 1.7% in HCA and 1.5% in iStar. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Lpl Holdings, Valeant Pharmaceuticals International and Gartner; with decreased exposures to Six Flags Theme Parks, Covenant Surgical and Westlake Chemical.
