

Bentham Wholesale High Yield Fund

Monthly fact sheet – August 2017

Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham Wholesale High Yield Fund had a total return (after fees*) of -0.01 percent in the month of August, underperforming the benchmark Merrill Lynch High Yield Cash Pay Constrained Index (hedged into AUD) after fees by 0.03 percent. On a before fees* basis the fund returned 0.04 percent for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.02 percent.

Fund Statistics

At month end, the Fund had a yield to maturity of 5.67% and running yield 6.12%, with the credit yield spread^ increasing by 17 basis points to 341 basis points during the month. The Fund had an interest rate duration of 3.48 years and credit duration of 3.63 years.

High Yield Market

For the month, 14 of the 24 industries had positive returns. The top performing industries in August were Aerospace, Transportation and Utility with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 0.88%, 0.82% and 0.75% respectively. The worst performing industries were Food And Drug, Energy and Telecommunications with returns of -1.49%, -0.88% and -0.65% respectively.

The credit yield spread^ for the Index increased by 25 basis points during the month to 377 basis points.

Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's asset allocations are 89.8% in High Yield Bonds, 0.0% in Syndicated Loans and 9.5% in Cash & Derivative Hedges.

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 10.3% in Broadcasting and Entertainment, 9.6% in Buildings and Real Estate and 6.9% in Finance. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.8% in Valeant Pharmaceuticals, 1.5% in iStar Inc and 1.4% in HCA Inc. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Vfh Parent, H&E Equipment Services and Trinseo; with decreased exposures to Post Holdings and Ladder Cap.
