

Bentham Global Opportunities Fund-Class F

Monthly fact sheet - April 2018

Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham Global Opportunities Fund had a total return (after fees*) of 0.89% in the month of April, outperforming the benchmark Bloomberg Ausbond Bank Bill Index after fees by 0.73%. On a before fees* basis the fund returned 0.93% for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.77%. The top performing contributors to performance were Global Syndicated Loans, Bank Capital Securities and Asset Backed Securities; whilst the bottom performing contributors to performance included Investment Grade Credit, RMBS and Collateralised Loan Obligations.

Fund Statistics

At month end, the Fund had a yield to maturity of 5.99% and running yield of 5.20%. Excluding cash the yield to maturity of the Fund was 6.27% and running yield of 5.51%. The credit yield spread^ increased by 12 bps to 331 bps during the month. The Fund had an interest rate duration of -1.71 years and credit duration of 4.85 years.

Portfolio Asset Allocation

During the month, exposures to Global High Yield, Global Syndicated Loans and Bank Capital Securities increased, whilst exposures to Cash, Corporate Credit and decreased. Current asset allocations are 7.4% in Global High Yield, 0.0% in Domestic Hybrids, 0.0% in European Convertibles, 48.8% in Global Syndicated Loans, 17.1% in Bank Capital Securities, 1.4% in Residential Mortgage Backed Securities, 3.6% in Asset backed securities, 14.4% in Collateralised Loan Obligations, 1.1% in Corporate Credit and 6.5% in Cash, Basis Trades and Derivatives.

Portfolio Industry and Issuer Exposures

The Fund's largest industry exposures are; 14.6% in Banking, 14.4% in CLO and 6.9% in Electronics. The Fund's top three company exposures are; 2.7% in Galaxy CLO, 2.5% in Lloyds and 2.1% in ABN Amro.

^{**} The monthly distribution return is calculated as the distribution amount declared for the month-end divided by the ex-distribution unit price at the start of the month. Bentham intends to achieve an average distribution rate of 3.75% - 4.25% for FY2018 with taxable income. If there is a shortfall of taxable income, the distribution could possibly include a capital return. The current distribution rate setting was based on the running yield of the Fund as at 30 June 2017 and assumes the Fund continues to achieve an equivalent yield for FY2018. Actual distributions, however, can differ from this setting because of future matters which are not known or able to be presently identified.
