Fund Aim

To provide diversified exposure to securities across global credit markets, with the flexibility to adapt its credit and cash exposure to suit market conditions across the credit cycle, and deliver consistent levels of income.

Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham Global Opportunities Fund had a total return (after fees) of 0.85% in the month of September, outperforming the benchmark (Bloomberg AusBond Bank Bill Index) by 0.69%. On a before fees basis the fund returned 0.89% for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.73%. The top performing contributors to performance included Global Syndicated Loans, Global Hybrids and Asset Backed Securities; whilst the bottom performing contributors included Investment Grade Credit, RMBS and Bank Capital Securities.

Fund Statistics

At month end, the Fund had a yield to maturity of 5.86% and running yield of 5.13%, with the credit yield spread decreasing by 10 bps to 308 bps during the month. The Fund had an interest rate duration of -1.16 years and credit duration of 4.70 years.

Portfolio Asset Allocation

During the month, exposures to Capital Securities, Basis Trades and Collateralised Loan Obligations increased, whilst exposures to Cash, Global High Yield and Asset Backed Securities decreased. Current asset allocations are -5.5% in Global High Yield, 2.4% in Global Hybrids, 55.0% in Global Syndicated Loans, 17.2% in Capital Securities, 13.8% in Collateralised Loan Obligations, -0.8% in Investment Grade Corporate Credit, 1.4% in Residential Mortgage Backed Securities, -1.2% in Government Backed Bonds (EM), 3.3% in Asset Backed Securities and 14.3% in Cash, Derivatives & Credit Hedged.

Portfolio Industry and Issuer Exposures

The Fund's largest industry exposures are: 16.0% in Banking, 15.2% in CLO and 6.1% in Electronics. The Fund's top three company exposures are: 2.6% in Galaxy Clo Ltd - 2013-15x, 2.3% in Lloyds Banking Group PLC and 1.9% in Abn Amro Bank Nv.

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




Portfolio Asset Allocation
