#### **Portfolio and Market Returns**

The Bentham High Yield Fund had a total return (after fees) of 0.97% in the month of March, outperforming the benchmark Merrill Lynch High Yield Cash Pay Constrained Index (hedged into AUD) after fees by 0.04%. On a before fees basis the fund returned 1.03% for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.11%.

## **High Yield Market**

For the month, 22 of the 23 industries had positive returns. The top performing industries in March were Utility, Retail and Broadcasting with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 2.52%, 2.31% and 2.10% respectively. The worst performing industries were Food And Drug, Wireless Communications and Energy with returns of -0.01%, 0.10% and 0.43% respectively.

The credit yield spread for the Index increased by 14 bps during the month to 402 bps.

## **Portfolio Exposures**

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 9.5% in Chemicals, Plastics and Rubber, 9.0% in Buildings and Real Estate and 7.1% in Diversified/Conglomerate Manufacturing. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.4% in PriSo Acquisition, 1.2% in CSC Holdings and 1.1% in Acrisure. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Panther BF Aggregator, Dell and NFP Corp; with decreased exposures to HCA, H&E Equipment Services and PDC Energy.




### **Portfolio Asset Allocation**




## **Regional Breakdown**
