Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham Syndicated Loan Fund NZD had a total return (after fees) of 0.59% in the month of November, outperforming the benchmark (Credit Suisse Leveraged Loan Index hedged into NZD) by 0.09%. On a before fees basis the fund returned 0.67% for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.16%.

Fund Statistics

At month end, the Fund had a yield to maturity of 5.43% and running yield of 5.10%, with the credit yield spread decreasing by 33 bps to 439 bps during the month. The Fund had an interest rate duration of 0.60 years and credit duration of 3.56 years.

Leveraged Loan Market

The discount margin (3 year) for the Index decreased by 14 bps during the month to 498 bps.

The top performing leveraged loan industries in November were Food And Drug, Information Technology and Retail with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 1.19%, 1.17% and 1.16% respectively. The worst performing loan industries were Energy, Metals/Minerals and Consumer Durables with returns of -1.95%, -0.97% and -0.29% respectively.

Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 9.7% in Electronics, 7.7% in Healthcare, Education and Childcare and 7.1% in Chemicals, Plastics and Rubber. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.4% in Level 3 Communications, 1.1% in Numericable and 1.0% in Euramax International. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Level 3 Financing, Genesee & Wyoming and Diamond Sports Group; with decreased exposures to BOWPK 2014-1X, Lucid Energy Group and American Airlines.

Bentham intends to achieve the distribution rate for FY2020 with taxable income. If there is a shortfall of taxable income, the distribution may possibly include a capital return.

The current distribution rate setting was based on the running yield of the Fund as at 30 June 2019 and assumes the Fund continues to achieve an equivalent yield for FY2020. Actual distributions, however, can differ from this setting because of future matters which are not known or able to be presently identified.




