Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham High Yield Fund had a total return (after fees) of 0.41% in the month of October, underperforming the benchmark ICE BofAML US Cash Pay High Yield Constrained Index³ (hedged into AUD) by 0.05%. On a before fees basis the fund returned 0.46% for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.01%.

High Yield Market

For the month, 18 of the 23 industries had positive returns. The top performing industries in October were Transportation, Food And Drug and Metals/Minerals with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 1.67%, 1.54% and 1.49% respectively. The worst performing industries were Broadcasting, Aerospace and Diversified Media with returns of -1.64%, -0.65% and -0.35% respectively.

The credit yield spread for the Index decreased by 12 bps during the month to 527 bps.

Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 10.4% in Buildings and Real Estate, 8.0% in Electronics and 7.8% in Diversified/Conglomerate Service. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.4% in Starwood Property Trust, 1.2% in Altice and 1.1% in Vertical. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Shift4 Payments, Getlink and BorgWarner; with decreased exposures to Kaiser Aluminum, Burger King and Sequa.





Regional Breakdown




High Yield Spread to Worst (bps)
