Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's sector allocations are 33.9% in US Broadly Syndicated Collateralised Loan Obligations (CLO), 24.2% in European CLO, 14.4% in UK Residential Mortgage Backed Securities (RMBS), 10.2% in Middle Market CLO, 6.6% in Cash & Derivatives, 3.8% in Aircraft ABS, 2.6% in US Commercial Real Estate (CRE), 2.5% in Australian RMBS, 0.9% in Credit Card ABS, 0.5% in Auto ABS, 0.3% in European RMBS and 0.1% in Personal Loan ABS.

Contributors

The top performing contributors to performance included UK RMBS and Aircraft ABS; whilst the bottom performing contributors included European RMBS and Personal Loan ABS.

Outlook

The Fund remains focused on the higher rated tranches of ABS issuance, offering investors a high credit quality, higher yielding, secured alternatives to investment grade corporate and government bonds, with low interest rate risk.

We place a high value on the structural benefits ("terms") typically included in global ABS structures to help preserve the principal of investors in the higher-rated tranches, such as cashflow priority, security, seniority, and reduction in leverage over time.




