Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham High Yield Fund had a total return (after fees) of 3.28% in the month of January, underperforming the benchmark ICE BofAML US Cash Pay High Yield Constrained Index3 (hedged into AUD) by 0.32%. On a before fees basis the fund returned 3.33% for the month, underperforming the benchmark by 0.27%.

High Yield Market

For the month, all industries had positive returns. The top performing industries in January were Diversified Media, Retail and Manufacturing with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 4.71%, 4.65% and 4.54% respectively. The worst performing industries were Utility, Food/Tobacco and Consumer Products with returns of 2.39%, 2.57% and 2.99% respectively.

The credit yield spread for the Index decreased by 51 bps during the month to 426 bps.

Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 11.3% in Diversified/Conglomerate Service, 11.2% in Electronics and 7.6% in Healthcare, Education and Childcare. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.4% in NFP, 1.1% in Speedway Motorsports and 1.0% in Foundation Building Materials. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to CCO Holdings LLC CCO Holdings Capital, GHX Ultimate Parent and Genesis Energy LP Genesis Energy Finance; with decreased exposures to Odeon Finco, CA Magnum and Cushman & Wakefield US Borrower.




Portfolio Asset Allocation



Regional Breakdown




High Yield Spread to Worst (bps)
