

# Bentham High Yield Fund

## November 2023

#### **Fund Aim**

To provide investors with a diversified exposure to the US high yield bond market with active allocation between individual securities and industries.

#### **Portfolio and Market Returns**

The Bentham High Yield Fund had a total return (after fees) of 3.81% in the month of November, underperforming the benchmark ICE BofAML US Cash Pay High Yield Constrained Index3 (hedged into AUD) by 0.46%. On a before fees basis the fund returned 3.87% for the month, underperforming the benchmark by 0.40%.

### **High Yield Market**

For the month, all industries had positive returns. The top performing industries in November were Broadcasting, Wireless Communications and Diversified Media with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 8.12%, 6.23% and 5.94% respectively. The worst performing industries were Metals/Minerals, Energy and Telecommunications with returns of 3.12%, 3.18% and 3.50% respectively.

The credit yield spread for the Index decreased by 439 bps during the month to 0 bps.

### **Portfolio Exposures**

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 10.5% in Diversified/Conglomerate Service, 7.5% in Electronics and 6.1% in Mining, Steel, Iron and Non-Precious Metals. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.1% in INTL FCStone, 1.0% in HealthEquity and 1.0% in Austin. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Axalta Coating Systems Dutch Holding B, Pike and Penske Automotive; with decreased exposures to Jacobs Entertainment, Kbr and Six Flags Entertainment.






#### **Portfolio Asset Allocation**



### **Regional Breakdown**




### **High Yield Spread to Worst (bps)**
