## **Fund Aim**

Fund aims to provide investors with access to a diversified, defensive, multi-sector credit strategy with a focus on providing steady monthly income with a focus on downside volatility.

### **Portfolio and Market Returns**

The Bentham Defensive Income Fund (Class I) had a before fees return of 0.06% for the month, underperforming the benchmark by 0.39%.

## **Portfolio Update**

Despite some equity indices giving up some gains in December, investment markets remained buoyant into year end, capping off a strong year for equity (particularly in the tech and Al sectors) and credit markets and a mixed year for rates.

The Fund was not active in the structured or corporate credit market during the month. Existing RMBS positions continued to amortise and de-risk. The Fund expects to participate in primary issuance once the markets fully reopen for 2025.

The mandate held a 6.24-year interest duration position at month end, primarily in the Australian, US and New Zealand markets.


