

# Bentham Global Opportunities Fund - Class A

### **Fund Aim**

The Fund aims to provide diversified exposure to securities across global credit markets, with the flexibility to adapt its credit and cash exposure to suit market conditions across the credit cycle, and deliver consistent levels of income.

### **Portfolio and Market Returns**

The Bentham Global Opportunities Fund - Class A had a before fees return of -0.32% for the month, underperforming the benchmark by 0.64%. The top performing contributors to performance included Investment Grade Credit, Capital Securities and Global Syndicated Loans; whilst the bottom performing contributors included Asset Backed Securities (ABS), Collateralised Loan Obligations (CLO) and Global Syndicated Loans.

### **Portfolio Asset Allocation**

During the month, exposures to Investment Grade Corporate Credit, Global High Yield and Government Backed Bonds (Emerging Market) increased, whilst exposures to Global Syndicated Loans, Basis Trades and Cash decreased. Current asset allocations are 44.9% in Global Syndicated Loans, 17.6% in Government Backed Bonds (Dev), 7.9% in Capital Securities, 2.2% in Investment Grade Corporate Credit, 1.9% in Collateralised Loan Obligations, 0.5% in Asset Backed Securities, 0.3% in Equity, -1.7% in Government Backed Bonds (EM), -25.4% in Global High Yield and 51.8% in Cash, Derivatives & Credit Hedges.

### **Portfolio Industry and Issuer Exposures**

The Fund's largest industry exposures are: 13.8% in Sovereign, Quasi Sovereign, Municipal, 12.8% in Banking and 6.7% in Electronics. The Fund's top three company exposures are: 2.7% in BNP Paribas, 2.3% in New Zealand Government and 2.3% in JPMorgan Chase & Co.






## **Regional Breakdown**
