The Fund aims to provide investors with a diversified exposure to the global syndicated loan market with an active allocation to investments in different industries, issuers and geographies.

Portfolio and Market Returns

The Bentham Syndicated Loan Fund NZD had a total return (after fees) of -1.12% in the month of February, underperforming the benchmark (Morningstar LSTA US Leveraged Loan Index hedged into NZD) by 0.24%. On a before fees basis the fund returned -1.05% for the month, underperforming the benchmark by 0.17%.

Fund Statistics

At month end, the Fund had a yield to maturity of 6.91% and running yield of 6.39%, with the credit yield spread increasing by 60 bps to 466 bps during the month. The Fund had an interest rate duration of 0.31 years and credit duration of 3.42 years.

Leveraged Loan Market

The top performing leveraged loan industries in February were Chemicals, Personal Care Products and Semiconductors & Semiconductor Equipment with returns (sector performance in USD terms) of 2.18%, 1.45% and 0.88% respectively. The worst performing loan industries were Building Products, Technology Hardware, Storage & Peripherals and Professional Services with returns of -3.91%, -3.49% and -

Portfolio Exposures

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 15.5% in Diversified/Conglomerate Service, 12.1% in Electronics and 8.0% in Finance. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.2% in Hologic, 0.9% in Abg Intermediate Holdings 2 and 0.8% in Corelogic. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Platin2025, KKR Apple and Ocs; with decreased exposures to Idemia Group S A S, Keter and Mariner Wealth Advisors.






Credit Rating Breakdown
