#### **Portfolio and Market Returns**

The Bentham High Yield Fund had a total return (after fees) of -1.13% in the month of March, underperforming the benchmark ICE BofAML US Cash Pay High Yield Constrained Index3 (hedged into AUD) by 0.04%. On a before fees basis the fund returned -1.07% for the month, outperforming the benchmark by 0.02%.

### **High Yield Market**

US High Yield spreads increased by 67bp over the month to 351bp. Within the market, B rated spreads increased 77bp to 364bp

#### **Portfolio Exposures**

The Fund's three largest industry exposures are 10.3% in Diversified/Conglomerate Service, 9.3% in Electronics and 7.9% in Finance. The Fund's top three company exposures are 1.2% in Cqp Holdco Lp / Bip-v Chinook Holdco Llc, 1.2% in Panther Finance Co and 1.1% in Arcosa Inc. During the month, the Fund increased its exposure to Focus Financial Partners, Tronox and Speedway Motorsports LLC; with decreased exposures to Sonic Automotive, Camelot Return Merger Sub and GFL Environmental.






#### **Portfolio Asset Allocation**



## **Regional Breakdown**




### **High Yield Spread to Worst (bps)**
